

Must write creatively and in grammatically correct English. Length of composition _ 3 paragraphs of 150-200 words.


GRAMMAR: Parts of speech, punctuation, direct/indirect speech, singular/plural, masculine/feminine, subject-verb agreement, simple analysis, simple synthesis, tense (simple and continuous)

VOCABULARY: Antonyms, Synonyms, Homophones, Converting verbs into nouns and adjectives.


